Travel Information

<u>By Car</u>

The city is just two hours from New York City, 90 minutes from Baltimore, three hours from Washington D.C. and about an hour from Lancaster County, Atlantic City and the New Jersey shore via major highways. Philadelphia is served by the PA Turnpike (I-276), I-76, I-476, I-95, US-1 and the New Jersey Turnpike.

<u>By Train</u>

Philadelphia is served by Amtrak. Amtrak's **30th Street Station** is minutes from the Pennsylvania Convention Center and Center City hotels.

<u>By Plane</u>

Philadelphia International Airport is just seven miles from Center City. SEPTA's R1 line directly links the airport to Philadelphia's downtown for a fast, hasslefree connection. Philadelphia taxis charge a flat rate of \$25 for travel between Center City and the airport. PHL is served by all major domestic carriers and is a major hub for US Airways.
