



# Minutes of GBM MAMCOAANA July 26<sup>th</sup>, 2014

Location: Toronto Downtown Mariott Eaton Centre (Center)

Time: 12.30 PM, July 26, 2014

Attendees: signed and scanned

Called to order by Dr. Bharat Kalra

1. Approval of minutes of GBM 2013 sought – seconded by Dr. Suneja and Dr. Sodhi. Unanimously approved

- 2. Financial Update provided by Dr. Bhushan Pandya and Dr. Ashutosh Gupta
  - Merril Lynch Account (Parent account) balance as of 07/2014 \$219,974.32; out of which about \$152,000 invested in CDs, bonds and other fixed income investments; and \$67,000 as liquid cash
  - ANB account (Active, current account) balance as of 07/23/2014 \$ 11,690 out of which \$5758 paid for convention
  - Convention account 2014 current has \$2441.00

Final on convention account 2014 and ANB account after closure of convention business for 2014.

Also, Dr. Gupta clarified that the parent account funds are used to subsidize the yearly convention, as well as pay the credential representative of MAMCOAANA in India. It may not be used for investing in AMA (a question raised by Dr. Renu Thapar). Dr. Rajiv Malik further suggested that voluntary donations to parent account are valid, Dr. Gupta agreed and clarified that as well.

- 3. Dr. Bharat Kalra announced that one new life member has been added to MAMCOAANA in the year 2013-2014 Dr. Harpreet Bajaj. He was welcomed to the MAMCOAANA family.
- 4. Dr. Ashutosh Gupta proposes that current president and 2 immediate past presidents form nomination committee for future office holders. Seconded by Dr. Suneja. Unanimously passed.
- 5. Dr. Dinesh Choudhry suggested that 5yr term as CME Chair be shortened. Dr. Khurana then moved the motion that CME Chair be elected for a period of 3yrs, and a separate CME Chair Elect post be created to come especially into play in the final year of office of the current CME Chair for smooth transitions and hand off. Seconded by Dr. Sodhi, unanimously approved.
- 6. Dr. Ajay Goel moved the motion that Drs. Ashutosh Gupta and Bhushan Pandya continue as lifetime position holders of Chairman By-Laws and Treasurer respectively unless they choose to step down or mentor another person to step in. Seconded by Dr. Ravinder Malik and passed unanimously. It was further clarified that this was proposed and passed mainly to allow ease of continuity and a firm anchor to MAMCOAANA operations.

Dr. Vivek Mishra's name as member at large was proposed by Dr. Alok Maheshwari in his absence, on his behalf. Objection was raised to him being proposed as office bearer even though he was not an attendee at the meeting. Dr. Maheshwari clarified on his behalf that his absence not be taken as a lack of interest, but as circumstantial. Motion proposed by Dr. Suneja to include Dr. Mishra as member at large – opposed by 2 votes, passed with easy majority.

Mention was made of the absence of Dr. Pathak in CME activities.


#### 8. MAMCOAANA and AAPI were discussed.

- Dr. Kalra commented on not being able to go to the national AAPI meeting as a Canadian citizen. Dr. Bhushan Pandya clarified that MAMCOAANA is a charter member of AAPI and can have representation in the governing body of AAPI. Since MAMCOAANA is an organization inclusive of MAMC alumnus of North America, and AAPI is exclusive to United States, a non US resident presence from MAMCOAANA would not be disallowed, but voting rights for AAPI would not be allowed based on AAPI's rules and by-laws. Dr. Suneja added that presence of a MAMCOAANA representative of the president who could have voting rights in AAPI would be beneficial; therefore for 2014 he did represent MAMCOAANA as a voting member in AAPI.
- Dr. Khurana was recognized for his tenure as national AAPI treasurer.
- The GBM was notified that Dr. Bhushan Pandya is running for AAPI treasurer Dr. Khurana move the motion, seconded by Dr. Suneja and unanimously endorsed (exclusive of Dr. Pandya). Dr. Khurana further clarified that official letter of support be sent by MAMCOAANA to this effect to AAPI

9. Dr. Pandya proposed that the GBM allow him permission to explore the possibility of a combined convention of the medical colleges of New Delhi. The concept in writing was read off to the GBM (attached with the minutes). Dr. Suneja seconded the proposal, and it was unanimously approved.

- 10. Dr. Maheshwari requested permission to explore and implement educational and interective opportunities with MAMC, through its current Dean, Dr. Deepak Tempe unanimously approved to proceed by the general body.
- 11. Dr. Bharat Kalra was universally praised, appreciated and thanked for his leadership and generous hosting of 2014 convention by all.
- 12. Convention 2015 Houston, TX. Tentative dates July 23<sup>rd</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup>. Organizer Dr. Randeep Suneja (&Mrs. Seema Suneja)






### MAMC Dean Attends MAMCOAANA 2014

For the last several years we have had the good fortune of working with the Dean of Maulana Azad Medical College (MAMC) on various projects. Each year, our previous Dean, Dr. Agarwal tried to join us for our annual convention but was unable to do so. Dr. Deepak Tempe was appointed Dean of MAMC about 18 months ago.
