## **Minutes of GBM MAMCOAANA July 24th, 2015**

Location: Residence of Dr. Randeep and Seema Suneja, Houston, TX

Time: 3.06PM, 7/24/2015

Attendees: Scanned signatures

Called to order by Dr. Randeep Suneja, President 2014-2015.

1. Approval of minutes of GBM 2014 sought – motion by Dr. Sodhi, seconded by Dr. Thapar, unanimously approved.
2. Update by Dr. Alok Maheshwari – all EC minutes posted on dropbox folder accessible to all EC members, in the minutes book
3. Revision of bylaws – update provided by Dr. Ashutosh Gupta. He updated that the new bylaws were posted online, and notices for the same sent out by postal mail on July 2<sup>nd</sup> 2015 by Dr. Suneja. A paper copy of the bylaws was also available in the GBM 2015 for review. Dr. Gupta thanked Dr. Jagdish Dang and Dr. Ajay Goel for the help they gave for drafting the revisions to the bylaws. Motion for approval of the revised bylaws by Dr. Suneja, seconded by Dr. Vikas Khurana. Approved unanimously. Dr. Gupta indicated that the new bylaws may need to be registered. This will be investigated and addressed further.
4. Application form on the website – Dr. Ashutosh Gupta made suggestions for revisions to the online form. Dr. Khurana to take responsibility for updating the membership application form and making it web compatible.
5. MAMCOAANA logo – Dr. Gupta updated the GBM about the cosmetic changes to the logo. The current shloka in the logo was discussed and decided to be changed. Once changed it was approved for upload to the website.
6. MAMCOAANA slogan – presented by Dr. Suneja. Dr. Raj Marwah suggested including 'excellence' in the slogan. Final result – Education, Excellence, Camaraderie. Motion for approval by Dr. Vimal Sodhi, seconded by Dr. Vivek Mishra, approved unanimously by all.
7. Dr. Suneja then commended the entire EC for its team spirit and camaraderie
8. Financial Update presented by Dr. Ashutosh Gupta (information gathered from Dr. Pandya as well) -
  - Merrill Lynch Account (Parent account) – balance as of 07/08/2015 – \$222,685.71
  - ANB account (Active, current account) – balance to date – \$2758.36
  - Convention account 2015 – \$30358.3

9. Accomplishments in 2014-2015 in addition –

- MAMCOAANA guest lecture series started in coordination with the Dean Dr. Tempe, with Dr. Alok Maheshwari facilitating the structure for MAMCOAANA. First lecture by Dr. Suneja in Nov 2014 was a great success. Dr. Thapar suggested adding a lecture series for MBBS students only. The consensus was to provide that within the framework of the current guest lecture series. Also stressed by Dr. Suneja and Dr. Maheshwari was to first consolidate the current lecture series, and to participate in submissions for the MAMC journal which the college is very interested in.

- Links to MAMC journal for submission of articles by any MAMC graduate, and for the guest lecture series to be made available on the MAMCOAANA website

- ECFMG verification is now completely electronic, the whole process now taking only weeks, compared to months before this change.

10. New crop of MAMC grads to have matched in 2015 and started their residencies were recognized and welcomed.

11. New Officers for 2015-2016

- President – Dr. Alok Maheshwari – proposal Dr. Gupta, seconded Dr. Khurana – small discussion with Dr. Dang stating that 2014 president elect should be the president per convention, since this was already voted on. It was explained that a voluntary discussion between Dr. Sharma (president elect 2014) and Dr. Maheshwari (secretary 2014) led to this idea to facilitate and encourage attendance of the 25<sup>th</sup> reunion batch in 2016, which happens to be the batch Dr. Maheshwari belongs to (1987). If the GBM approves then Dr. Alok Maheshwari to be president, and host for 2016; and Dr. Tarang Sharma to remain as president elect. Approved unanimously thereafter.

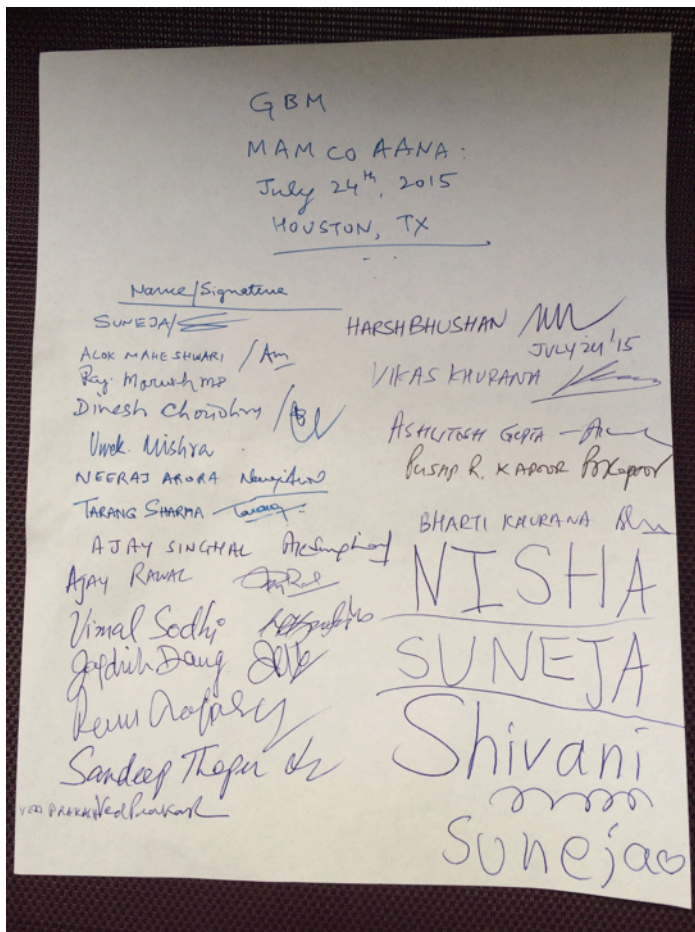
(Further, Dr. Rakesh Nanda had been unanimously elected as permanent EC member for life in 2012, and completes the list for members at large as a courtesy)

- CME committee – proposed chair Dr. Bharti Khurana. Awaited message from Dr. Bupesh Kaul (in absentia for this GBM) to confirm if he is able to take over from Dr. Dinesh Choudhry as originally planned, or not.

- Membership Committee – proposed Dr. Vibhor Wadhwa pending clarification of his membership status.



11. Site for 2016 MAMCOAANA – Minneapolis, July 2015. Exact date to be decided within the next 3mths.
12. Meeting registration – proposal to reduce to 50% of actual rate for retired, retired or active military, residents and any MAMC alumni from India.
13. Proposed for future visits from the Dean – waive registration fee, MAMCOAANA will pay for 1 economy class ticket and hotel. Spouse of the Dean not included in this.
14. Proposed invitation to LHMC grads in USA as guests of MAMCOAANA. They may hold their own GBM, but otherwise would register as guests and participate in MAMCOAANA activities as decided by MAMCOAANA. GBM agrees to try this for 2016. Dr. Maheshwari will explore.
15. GBM congratulated Dr. Metre officially for her work. She thanked MAMCOAANA for welcoming her.
16. The meeting was adjourned at 4.20pm
17. Addendum – 7/25/2016 1209pm – after receiving communication from Dr. Bupesh Kaul declining participation in 2015 CME committee, Dr. Bharti Khurana was unanimously elected as CME chair. Dr. Choudhry steps down as chair, but remains part of the committee and available to assist. Dr. Bupesh Kaul not part of CME committee for 2015.

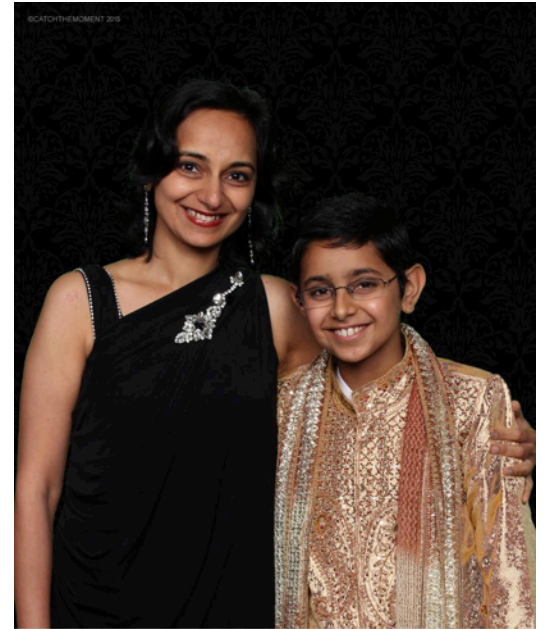

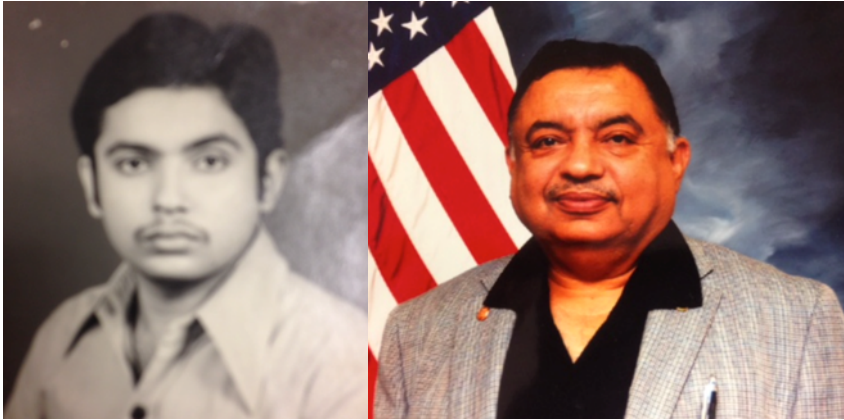

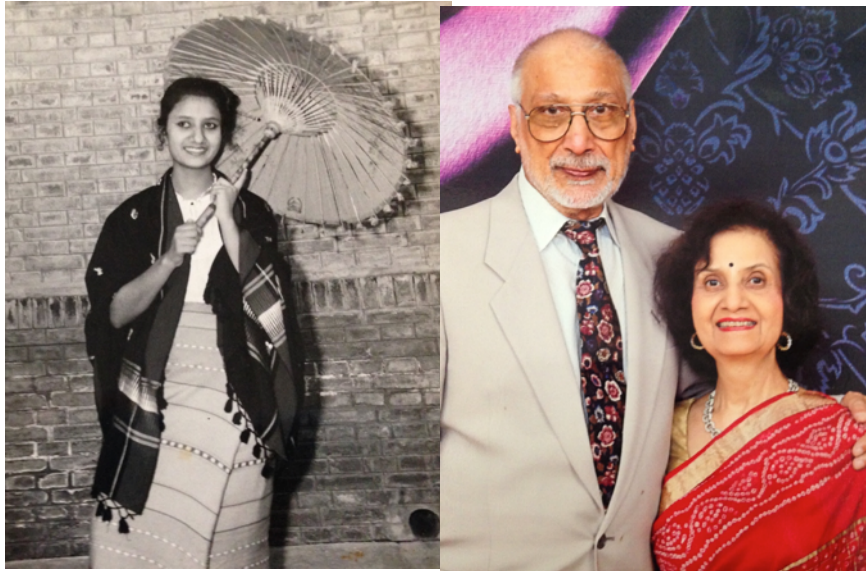
