<u>By Car</u>

Columbus is served by I-71 (north to south), I-70 (west to east), and I-270 (encircles the city). Proceed to I-71 from these highways. The hotel is located off I-71. If travelling I-71 south then exit 121 for Gemini place and drive on to Lyra Drive for Hilton. If travelling I-71 N then exit 121 onto Polaris Parkway and proceed to Lyra Drive for Hilton.
