

MINUTES OF GBM MAMCOAANA 2017 ANNUAL CONVENTION

Location: Hilton Columbus/Polaris, Columbus, OH Time: 12.30pm, July 15, 2017 Attended by all MAMC alumni at MAMCOAANA Convention 2017

- 1. The meeting was called to order by Dr. Tarang Sharma, President 2016-2017.
- 2. Minutes of GBM 2016 were presented for approval. Dr. Randeep Suneja moved to approve, seconded by Dr. Vikas Khurana, approved unanimously.
- 3. Financial Update presented by Treasurer Dr. Bhushan Pandya as of December 31, 2016.
- Merrill Lynch Account (Reserve account) -Balance \$237,435.00
- ANB account (Convention account) balance to date \$5500. ANB operation account \$40,500.00

The report was approved unanimously.

- 4. 2017 Update by Dr. Tarang Sharma, President, MAMCOAANA.
 - Approximately 20 new life members have joined
 - Approximately 300 life members so far
 - 50 percent discount for new life membership approved for 2017
- The following new Officers for nominated for 2017-2018 by the Executive committee. Nominations were invited from the floor. None were presented. President Elect - Dr. Sunil Malkani Secretary - Dr. Ajay Rawal Treasurer -Dr. Bhushan Pandya Chairman, By-laws -Dr. Ashutosh Gupta Editor- Dr Tarang Sharma , Webmaster- Dr Nikhil Goyal Members at large -Dr Randeep Suneja, Dr Indranil Chakraborty,Dr Alok Maheshwari, Dr Anuj Bhargava, Dr Bobby Batra CME chair - Dr. Bharti Khurana

The Slate of nominees were unanimously elected.

6. The Credential Verification for MAMC graduates was being facilitated through the efforts of MAMCOAANA with efforts of Dr. Bhushan Pandya and the then Dean. The current process is being overseen by Dr. Hadke (MAMC faculty). MAMCOAANA can facilitate the process through him to help our members. MAMC has a designated staff handling this process. On line verification has been established between MAMC and ECFMG with the help of MAMCOAANA for the last several years. MAMCOAANA is no longer supporting this process financially.

7. Dr Tarun Marwaha raised the issue of California requiring certain rotation in psychiatry for License for psych rotation requirements. Information was shared that the Department of Medicine in MAMC can usually give letter of documentation for psych exposure for 4 weeks in medical school.

8. Dr Indranil Chakraborty volunteered to help with twitter account in response to the Need for tech savvy volunteers for Social Media. He suggested that we should discuss the goals of social media account.

9. Dr Maheshwari initiated Discussion for Uploading CME SESSIONS to MAMCOAANA Website for MAMC students- as an alternative to a Voluntary in person Lectures at MAMC. There is an opportunity for skype presentations particularly for the department of OBGyn per the communication between the Department Chair Dr. Anjali Tempe and Dr. Pandya.

10. Discussion about the purpose for the MAMCOAANA was led by Dr. Maheshwari. This led to the possibility of Medical Mission trips abroad, organized by MAMCOAANA. Dr Vikas Khurana made a motion to approve up to \$5000.00 towards this project which was seconded and unanimously approved.

11. Dr Tarang Sharma introduced Dr Bhushan Pandya and announced his intention to run for the office of National AAPI treasurer and encouraged Alumni to get membership to AAPI and vote for him. The executive committee has decided to support him in all possible ways. He is currently the President of the Medical Society of Virginia, immediate past Chair of AMA-IMG Governing council and served MAMCOAANA as the President in the past and presently serving as the treasurer. His work was applauded.

12. Dr Tarang Sharma was applauded for the excellent meeting and activities.

13. Dr. Vivek Mishra the incoming President was introduced. He informed the general body about the next Annual convention in Chicago- July 26-29th, 2018 at Hyatt Centric, Magnificent Mile. All members were encouraged to spread the word and attend.

14. The meeting was adjourned at 1.30 pm.

Dr Syed Nihal Ahmed Rizvi joined MAMC after his MSC in 1959. He was a very gentle and sweet person and a thorough gentleman. We fondly started calling him the 'girls' rep' when he ran to be our class rep. It was meant to gently tease and being the kind gentleman he was, he never objected. He carried that name for a long time to our delight. He was very studious and worked hard. He used to read for a class a day before and always came prepared. After MBBS in 1964, he started to work with Dr Hari Vaishnava. Dr Vaishnava was the head of medicine, a very handsome, tall and powerful personality. Dr Rizvi stayed with Dr Vaishnav and made great progress. He started research on rickets. He mentored many fellow doctors for their MD thesis. Dr Rizvi will always remain alive in our hearts as a sweet kind and gentle person.
